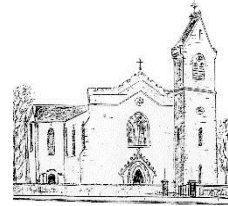

Nativity of St John the Baptist
Sunday 24th June



Names have special meanings, sometimes a new child's name is thought out well in advance, sometimes only when a baby arrives can parents decide. We often name a boy after his father or grandfather.

In today's Gospel it is the mother of St John the Baptist, Elizabeth, who gives her son his name, which means "God has been gracious."

Like so often in the Gospels, she is a woman taking a role above that which is normal in ancient Jewish society - it was usual for a father to name a child, and the name was usually a family name.

This hints at the special life John will lead, preaching repentance powerfully to the Jews.
