Jesus did not take too kindly to his disciples being overzealous in keeping those in need away from him.

We remember he rebuked them for keeping small children away from him, telling them that "theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven", and telling us that we need to be pure and innocent like children if we expect to gain Paradise.

This week he again disregards their concerns, he stops and calls Bartimaeus the blind beggar to him. This miracle assures us of two things about Jesus; one, that he has the power to heal or cure us, and two, he listens out to hear our cries for help above the noise of the world around us.

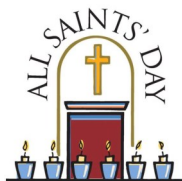
