Reminder—Please return your CHY3

A reminder to those who recently received a CHY3 Tax form to sign and return it to the Parish Office as soon as possible. The Parish claims tax relief on annual contributions of over €250 under the Revenue's Charitable Donations Scheme. To do this we need to have an up to date tax refund form.

Parishioners who submitted a tax refund form 5 years ago now need to sign one for a further 5 years.
