### *“Enlighten the eyes of our mind”*

The three readings today have one common thread; perseverance.

When the people of Israel in the story of Exodus are attacked by Amalekites, Moses intercedes with God to save his people. They are winning while Moses has his arms upraised, losing when he lowers them from tiredness. In a long battle we need our friends, like Aaron and Hur here, to keep us from tiring.

In the gospel parable today, the widow perseveres with the judge, and eventually he concedes and helps her case “or she will worry me to death”. In this story Christ is telling us that if we are steadfast and we keep on asking God, then he will see justice done.

Paul is telling Timothy the same thing. Keep to what you have been taught and know to be true. Proclaim the message of Christ, and welcome or unwelcome, insist on it. Reflecting this exhortation from Paul to proclaim the message of Christ, today's Gospel Acclamation prays that the Father of Jesus Christ will enlighten the eyes of our mind, so that we can see what hope his call holds for us.

What a beautiful thought! Keep the eyes of our mind, the windows to our soul open, and hope will come to us.

### Reminder—Please return your CHY3

A reminder to those who recently received a CHY3 Tax form to sign and return it to the Parish Office as soon as possible. ### Reminder - Vetting Invitation

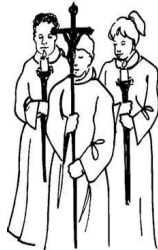
