Real power

Very interesting readings this week. Paul makes a very eloquent and gracious appeal to the Corinthians for help. He praises them highly, which will make it difficult for them to refuse or say no. We First World Christians need to pay close attention to this. Those to whom much has been given, much is expected.

In the Gospel this week, we get a close look at the real power of Jesus, though no doubt he would tell it as the real power of faith. The lady with the long term haemorrhage problem, we could think of her as the Patron Saint of Embarrassment, she believes so deeply in the power and goodness of Jesus, she only wishes to touch the hem of his clothes and feels she will be well again. She does, and she is. Jesus feels the flow of grace healing her, and seeks her out. "Go in peace and be free from your complaint" he tells her.

And faith again intervenes, when the little girl of Jairus dies before Jesus can get to her house. Jesus had great concern for Jairus, telling him not to be afraid, only have faith. He calls to the little girl, having told those present her death was only a sleep. "Talitha kum" And of course she got up as she was told. We don't get to see such miracles in this time.

But we are all called by Jesus to get up, and have faith.
