## Christmas Masses in St Mary's Church

In line with Government regulations for Christmas Masses we are only able to accommodate **50 people at each Mass**. This year Christmas will be so different from other years. We have decided to hold four Masses on Christmas Eve and four on Christmas Day.

**Christmas Eve:** 3.00 pm, 5.00 pm., (which will be Family Masses - especially those with young children). There will also be Masses at 7.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m.

**Christmas Day:** 8.45 a.m., 10.00 a.m., 11.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m.

On Monday 21<sup>st</sup>, Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December we will have two Masses each day - 10.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. The obligation to attend Mass on Christmas Day is suspended during Covid. You can attend any of the Masses on Christmas week. **All Masses over Christmas will be livestreamed—[www.maynoothparish.org](http://www.maynoothparish.org)**

We will be issuing tickets to attend Masses for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, which will mean that there will be **two tickets only** per household. The 3.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. Masses on Christmas Eve will be limited to 12 families. **Unfortunately, due to the limited amount of people we can fit into the Church the Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas day will only allow entry with a ticket.** If you do not have a ticket we will be unable to let you attend.
