Notes to the 2021 Statement

Two collections are taken up during Masses i.e. The Priests Common Fund (2021: €24,165) from which the priests of the parish are paid, and SHARE (€14,516). These are paid directly to the Archdiocese and do NOT form part of parish income.

Dues monies received (€29,759), is lodged to the Priests Common Fund, which goes towards payment of salaries to priests in the Archdiocese. They are remitted in their entirety to the Archdiocese, and therefore do NOT form part of parish income.

Repairs and Maintenance expenses includes the repainting of Ladychapel church and associated costs, and the treatment of the cedarwood in the Pastoral Centre.

Any donations over €250 per year are enhanced, where the parish can claim tax back on the donations at no extra cost to the parishioner.
