Christ's use of parables in his teaching at times can seem like the message is hidden from us in the story, not as clearly told as we might like. In Matthew this week it does become more obvious that the objective of Jesus was about growth. Growing the Kingdom of God.

The listeners are told that the seeds of our faith when sown grow while we are asleep, and will keep growing while we are awake. The farmer in the parable does not know exactly how the growth happens. But he will know when it matures and it is time for the harvest.
