Baptise them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The order of this week's readings is a little different than the above in that the first reading defines the Father, the second from Romans defines the Spirit and our relationship as heirs and siblings with Christ, and lastly Matthew's Gospel gives us the good news that Jesus the Son wants us to know that He is with us always, even to the end of time.

Whatever order we relate to the Blessed Trinity it always brings us back to the one concept of the loving family. Our own Saint Patrick taught this concept using the trefoil leaves of the shamrock to show the unity between God the Father of the Old Testament, God the Son in Jesus Christ, and the God the Holy Spirit giving us the

Christ, and the God the Holy Spirit giving us the right to call Abba, Father, and the grace to be siblings with Christ.

Christ's instructions to the eleven disciples extends the spirit of family to all the nations of the earth, "baptise them and teach them" they were

told. We as their successors will do the same, so let them know us as brothers and sisters in Christ by our behaviour and by our Spirit.
