### *A Sign of the Times*

Exodus reminds us of the 10 Commandments as they were given to Moses, a moral template for Jews and Christians alike to follow God's Words of Eternal Life.

Paul in his letter to the Greeks of Corinth notes that the Jews need signs, or miracles, where the Greeks seek instead for wisdom.

When Jesus drove the traders and moneychangers from the temple, he was challenged on what authority he could do such a thing. His answer that he could raise the temple of his body in three days was the definitive sign of the times, the ultimate Easter miracle of his passion, cross and resurrection.

## Postponement of Sacraments



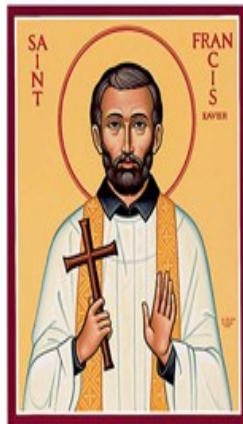
Following a zoom meeting with Archbishop Farrell last week all Baptisms, First Holy Communions and Confirmation Ceremonies have been postponed for the moment.
