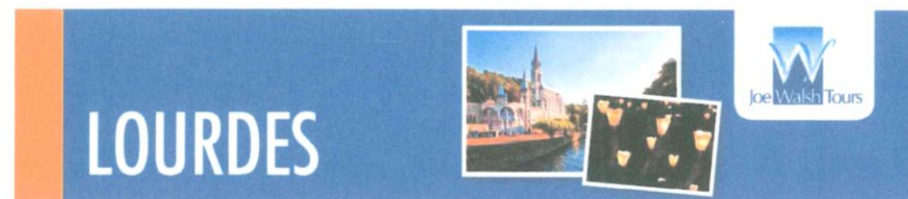
We continue to meet on Monday nights at 8pm in Pastoral Centre. New members are always welcome to join the group. Contact Maire @ 087 124 8739.

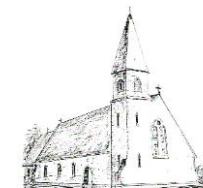

Sunday of the Word of God

The power of the Spirit within Him

This Sunday is very special in the life of Christ, it is the day when he proclaims who He is and what is His mission.

The Old Testament reading sets the tone, as the people of God listen closely to the Law of God as read and explained by Ezra the Scribe. Nehemiah the prophet tells them "This day is sacred to our Lord, do not be sad"

We have Saint Paul making a difficult simile by explaining to us that all the people of the Church are as one body working with the power of the Spirit, and this body needs all parts large or small to work with Christ, each part, each one is indispensable. This can be read as a call for unity and inclusiveness in an expanding Church, a call we ourselves need to heed ever more these days.

And then we have Saint Luke, the Doctor, the practical one giving the account in his matter-of-fact way of Jesus returning to the synagogue in Nazareth and openly declaring his intentions as read from the scroll of Isaiah. "He has sent me to bring good news to the poor" You would think this would be music to the ears of those in the temple. As we will see later, Christ knew his words would be a challenge for his neighbours.
